Thank you for collecting used stamps for Sight Research UK. Together, we can beat sight loss faster.

Below we have included some information regarding stamp collections to help you but, if you have any questions, please don't hesitate to get in touch. We would love to hear from you.

- Contrary to what most people think, older stamps (pre 2008) are usually not as valuable. We get most return from modern stamps – the ones with security tabs.
- Please try to cut out stamps with a finger's width/1cm of paper all the way round. Less than this can be unusable but more unnecessarily increases the cost of collection for us. See below:

Please do not put in any pre-printed postage such as the large gold labels

- Please separate the stamps into British/foreign (Channel Island and Isle of Mann count as foreign). No other sorting is necessary.
- Please pack the envelope as evenly as possible and try not to over fill it.
- Please hold onto the envelope until you feel it is sufficiently filled, to minimise collection costs for us.

We would like to thank you for your donation and send you a replacement envelope, if you would like one (or more), please fill out the slip below. You can also request a small display collection box which is suitable for reception areas, staff rooms, offices etc.
